CASE STUDY 1 – "*FonRedess*"

GENERAL FRAMEWORK/ PROBLEM STATEMENT

Fonredes is an organisation based in Andalusia, committed to the Solidarity Economy and the Social Economy. Its mission is to facilitate financial access to social entrepreneurship that currently and due to market circumstances are excluded from the financial system. FonRedess is a fund for the support and accompaniment of social entrepreneurship projects through the granting of interest-free, refundable monetary aid.

In this way, we channel economic resources that generate a social impact and transform the territory through small projects led by great people.

These are monetary aids for social and solidarity economy projects, with a maximum of €6,000 per project and €5,000 for each job created, not exceeding €10,000 in total.

This aid is granted interest-free, to be repaid over a period of 3 years, with a 6-month grace period and the only increase being the CPI. ACTIVITIES

ACTIVITIES

The Textile Triangle: Triangulo Textil was created with the mission of recovering local textile production that generates economic and social value in the fashion industry and promotes the necessary transformation towards a sustainable model: Slow Fashion.

We are looking for brands with sustainable models that value production and prioritise quality finishes and social responsibility in their value chain.

Reimbursable aid: 3.000 Euros.

IMPACT

FonRedess is present in 27 social and solidarity economy entrepreneurship projects, awarding €103,306.46 in Reimbursable Grants, providing support to these projects.

Reimbursable aid: 5,000 Euros. <https://albalcircular.org/?lang=es>

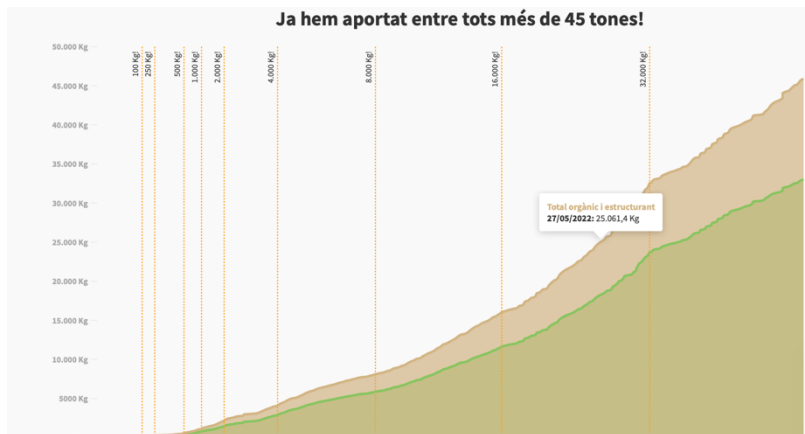
ACTIVITIES

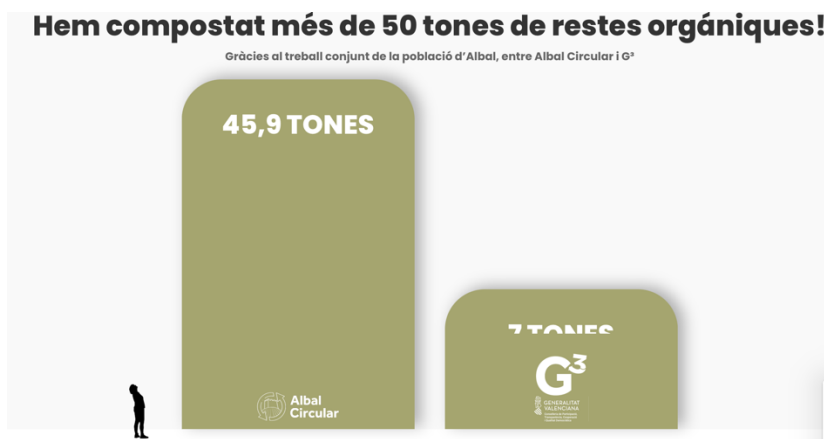
White Paper: the steps taken

CASE STUDY 3 – *La Sureña*

GENERAL FRAMEWORK/ PROBLEM STATEMENT

Since its beginnings, the cooperative has managed the La Surera hostel as an accommodation space and a place for meetings and exchanges to carry out the rest of its rural revitalisation projects around the following axes: recovery and enhancement of the cultural and natural heritage, agriculture, transformation of food products, environmental education, cultural and artistic activities, training. The cooperative is currently in the midst of a transition phase with the aim of transforming the hostel into a collective space for activities, the La Surera Rural Meeting Space.

ACTIVITIES

Among the activities developed by the organisation we find the following: food courses, conscious, art, wellness, camps, environmental education, fundraising, alternative, festivals, arts, performing arts, water route, environmental volunteering. All these projects have a great impact as explained below.

IMPACT

The impact of this initiative, they have already managed to implement more than 20 projects. It is a team of professionals that includes engineers, agronomists, designers, graphic designers, audiovisual artists, experts in labour, multinationals, etc. They have created inclusive projects that promote that other people can add up based on abundance, both material and spiritual and with a gender perspective.
